Buffalo Bayou Partnership Bayou Buddies and Houston Young People for the Arts

When: Saturday, February 28th - 5-8 pm (public screening begins at 6:30 pm)

Where: 723 N. Drennan (see directions below)

What: Bayou Buddies will host a reception for its members and friends, including special guests, Houston Young People for the Arts, before the Junkyard Drive In: Texas Oil on Film event. The reception will introduce young professionals to Buffalo Bayou Partnership's art program and include a brief introduction by Andrea Grover, Aurora Picture Show, and Matt Coolidge, Center for Land Use Interpretation (CLUI), who have coordinated the drive in film event.

Junkyard Drive In: CLUI and Aurora presents drive-in screening of industrial and information films on the subject of oil, at the site of a former auto junkyard on Buffalo Bayou. Pack your tailgate picnic, or buy dinner from the mobile taco stand, and then tune in your car radio to learn about the industry that makes Texas tick. Junkyard Drive-In is part of the Buffalo Bayou Partnership's new public art initiative, Confluence: Points of View on Buffalo Bayou, and organized in conjunction with Texas Oil: Landscape of an Industry, an exhibition of the Center for Land Use Interpretation, on view at Blaffer Gallery, January 17-March 29.

Cost: Free for Bayou Buddies and HYPA Members/ \$10 Non-members
Includes St. Arnold's beer and Junkyard snacks!

Supplies: Blankets, chairs, groovy car for movie screening following reception.

Parking: Drive in and park as directed. Attendees will view the film from personal vehicles.

Directions:

From I-10

- Head I-10 East (going towards Beaumont), exit Waco and make a right on Waco.
- Stay on Waco (North York St) until you hit Navigation and make a left on Navigation.
- Turn left onto Drennan Street. Follow the street to 723 N. Drennan (next door to Biodiesel).

Or head to Ninfa's - Just 1 mile East of Ninfa's on Navigation
