Highlights and Amenities


- Located at the Wortham Insurance Visitor Center, The Water Works sits atop the historic Buffalo Bayou Park Cistern, a former underground water reservoir that has been transformed into a site for history tours and art exhibitions.
- Hike and bike trails and waterfront views are steps away.
- Conveniently located public restrooms are on ground level.
- A Visitor Center and gift shop are downstairs.
- This site is adjacent to a 47-space surface parking lot with additional parking along Sabine Street and Allen Parkway.

Dimensions and Maximum Capacity

- The Water Works (all spaces) – 401' x 204' (Maximum Capacity – 3,400 people)
- The Brown Foundation Lawn – 250' x 151' (Maximum Capacity – 3,065 people)
- Hobby Family Pavilion – 71' x 20' (Maximum Capacity – 115 people)
- Wortham Insurance Terrace – 80' x 33' (Maximum Capacity – 220 people)

Base Pricing

- \$10,000 – The Water Works (all three spaces)
- \$4,500 – The Brown Foundation Lawn
- \$3,000 – Wortham Insurance Terrace
- \$2,500 – Hobby Family Pavilion
- Requirements: 90 days before the event, 25% of payment and a signed contract
30 days before the event, remainder of payment is due

 - (4) 120V/10 amp wall outlets
 - (21) Recessed stage lights
 - (48) Globe lights
 - (2) Amplifier panels
 - Electric panel
